PADI OPEN WATER DIVER AND JUNIOR OPEN WATER DIVER COURSE

Warm greetings from Tioman!

Thank you for your interest on our diving facilities. We are a registered PADI 5 Star Dive Resort that is wholly owned and run by Berjaya Tioman Resort and staffed with PADI Instructors and Dive masters. We organize daily dive trips and schedule dive courses from beginner (PADI Scuba Diver or Open Water Diver) to Divemaster level. The equipment we use is ScubaPro regulators and BCD's. Following are the details of the diving course.

Course Description

PADI Open Water Diver is the most popular diver program in the world and your ticket to a lifetime of intense adventure. You will get to learn about scuba fundamentals, equipments, and techniques. Plus, skills practice diving in a pool or pool like body of water and experience several of Open Water Dives in the sea with an Instructor. You can also continue your dive training with further courses. Virtually anyone in good health and reasonably fit can learn to scuba dive. Participants as young as 10 years old may participate in the PADI Open Water Diver program and receive junior credential until they reach 15 years of age.

The Open Water Diver certification is a full entry- level certification you'll earn by successful completion of the program.

Kindly be informed that the PADI Open Water Diver course will take about three full days excluding arrival and departure days. On the arrival day the participant need to come to the Dive Centre as soon as possible to collect course manual for immediate reading (self study). The class will start the next morning at 8.30am and will finish around 4.30 to 5.00 pm. All participants must be medically fit for diving such as free from heart and lung diseases, etc. If in doubt please consult your local physician.

Please go through the medical declaration form that is attached. If any of the answer is **YES** to a question in the medical questionnaire then the participant is required to obtain a physician's approval to participate in scuba diving. The medical approval form must be presented to us upon your registration.

Course Fee:

Important note:~

- This course is performance based rather than time based. Therefore, the above schedule is subjected to change as required.
- While all due care will be taken to complete the course on time, participant may have to extend their stay if unable to complete the course requirement due to unforeseen reasons. Extension stay will be at participant responsibilities and own expenses.

Equipment and Facilities Provided for Usage During the Training:

- A complete set of diving equipment include the 3mm shorty wetsuit.
- Air-condition classroom equipped with Multimedia, TV, video & DVD players.
- Confined water training either in private swimming pool or beach.
- 4 open water training dives in Renggis Island.
- Hot Drinks

Requirements:

- Minimum age is 10 years old.
 - All participants must be comfortable in the water and able to swim/snorkeling at the surface without any floatation aids.
 - All participants must be medically fit for diving such as free from heart and lung diseases, etc. If in doubt please consult your family/local physician.
 - All participants have to register at the Dive Centre on the arriving day to collect the PADI Open Water Diver manual for self-study.
- **Advance confirmation on your reservation for any scuba diving courses is highly recommended to prevent disappointment due to overbooking.**

Flying After Diving Recommendations

1) For repetitive dives and/or multi-day dives within the no decompression limits, a minimum pre - flight surface interval of 18 hours is suggested.
