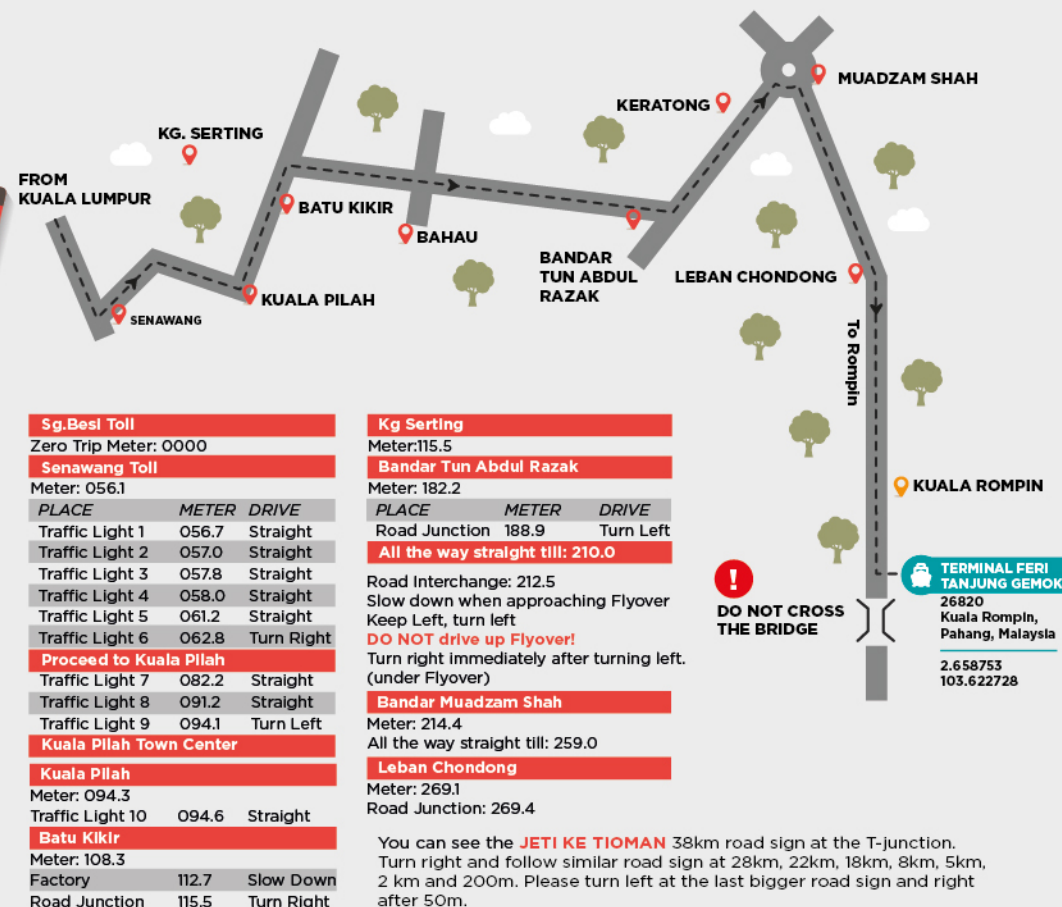

GETTING THERE



Berjaya Tioman Resort is located off the east coast of Peninsular Malaysia in the state of Pahang. Getting to the resort requires travelling by road to Terminal Feri Tanjung Gemok or Mersing Jetty, followed by a 2 hours ferry ride from the jetty.

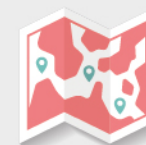

Head towards Jalan Station and continue on Route 50 to Mersing until you arrive at the jetty

Take the Senawang exit (Exit 220) and continue along Route 51 to reach Kuala Pilah

JOHOR BAHRU Continue north on JB EDL – Eastern Dispersal Link (AH2)



MUST-EATS

- Braised duck noodles at Kedai Masakan Itik Taika Huat
- Nasi lemak and lontong at Ambang Pesona d'Cerry
- Traditional wood oven baked banana cake from Hiap Joo Baker

KOTA TINGGI

Take the Pandan exit (Exit 1404B) and continue on Jalan Kota Tinggi (Route 3) to Kota Tinggi

MERSING JETTY

Head onto Route 3 from Jalan Kota Tinggi and continue until you arrive at Mersing Jetty

Continue on the North South Expressway (E2) and turn off at the Ayer Hitam exit (Exit 244)
